

Camp Cou tts – Waterfall Camp Rules

Scouting is a volunteer organisation and as such all work and cleaning is carried out by volunteers. Your help in keeping the camp ready for the next group is a must and the following instructions are to be carried out whilst at the camp. These rules are also part of the conditions of hiring the camp.

A green Camp Cou tts booklet will be given to you, by the Camp Warden upon your arrival.

General Rules

Any directions given to you by the Camp Wardens must be adhered to.
Eg. Fire Restrictions etc

Car parking is limited so please park efficiently in the designated car park out the front of the camp.

Keep noise to a minimum as excessive noise may disturb other campers.

Rubbish must be removed as there is no rubbish collection available at the site.

Aluminium Cans may be recycled in the bins provided.

Anything moved during your stay must be returned to its original location.

You need to notify the Camp Warden of anything that seems out of place on your arrival.

Any breakages that occur during your stay will be paid for by you at the appropriate replacement cost.

Should you be leaving the camp for any reason (hiking), please notify the camp warden.

First Aid

It is the responsibility of the Hirer to have a current First Aid Kit (suitable for there activity) available at all times.

Halls

At the end of your stay the halls must be swept out and any tables and chairs need to be stacked accordingly.

Bunkrooms

Mattresses must not be removed from the bunkrooms.

Floors must be swept/mopped out at the end of your stay.

Amenities

Toilets, showers, floors and basins must be cleaned at the end of your stay. The camp warden on site will provide you with the equipment needed to do this.

Kitchens

At the end of your stay the fridges/freezers must be cleaned out and turned off.

All cooking equipment including stoves and ovens must be cleaned.

Tables and chairs stacked in the corner of the building.

ANY BREACH OF THE ABOVE RULES OR THOSE STATED IN THE GREEN CAMP COUTTS BOOKLET MAY RESULT IN THE FORFEIT OF THE ENTIRE BOND.
